RICARDO LOWENBERG - *Painting / Sculpture*



A native of Mexico City, Ricardo Lowenberg has lived in Tampico on the coast of the Gulf of Mexico since 1983. Tampico embraced the artist with a great deal of pride, where his work was first exhibited in 1995 and continuously displayed with much acclaim at distinguished art galleries. It was very quickly that Lowenberg became one of the greatest exponents of contemporary Mexican paintings.

Lowenberg's art is a conglomeration of visual ideas, form, color, space, emotions, and stories that merge to create a remarkable body of work. Originating from his love of music and his exemplary talent in interior design, and influenced by master Impressionists and sculptors, as well as the great Mexican muralists, he creates engaging allegories and beautiful portraiture interspersed with colorful flora and landscapes. Lowenberg's paintings and sculptures capture beauty, strength, acceptance, harmony, and peacefulness.

The quality of Lowenberg's work is championed by many successful exhibitions in Mexico, Europe, and the United States, most notably his exclusive exposition at the Centro Cultural Poliforum Siqueiros in Mexico City, which included 32 pieces that now reside in prestigious private collections.

Lowenberg's work lies in the essence of the people he paints and sculpts, their stories, surroundings, and continuous self-discovery that emerges on the canvas and bronze. It is through this visual storytelling and observation that his paintings connect the viewer with a sense of profoundness and wonder.

Ricardo spends most of his time in the USA and Mexico and travels the world for a continuous quest for self-discovery, learning and inspiration.

ARTIST STATEMENT:

I have been painting professionally for over 25 years, and my fascination with the act of painting, color, and people bring me a great source of enjoyment and satisfaction. Through the years, my work and ability as an artist continue to evolve, and this state of change it's something that energizes me, that we all should embrace; it is the pursuit of transformation and experimentation that growth occurs. As a painter, I am continually seeking to evolve and explore new techniques, to exceed what was previously achieved or renew my creative process from scratch. In this constant search, many years ago, I began to discover the possibilities of sculpture. Although my initial interest in sculpture started as a temporary exploration for a specific project, I have now resumed it as a process in and of itself, that I have named: The Magic Process.

For me, sculpting is a means of personal expression that allows me to react to established parameters of perfection. In essence, this is what originally inspired me to work in the visual arts, and it remains my motivation today. Through this process, I have learned to not only embrace but also to love imperfection. I find that when I sculpt, I am fully present. As with my pictorial works, I fall in love with the sculptures. As I gaze at the works, again and again, I contemplate the dazzling anatomy of the human form. I am inspired by the possibilities of the feminine body, the abundant and generous curves, and the sensuality and innocence they represent— also the male form with angular features and defined muscle but very delicate gaze.

The Magic Process is a series of twelve sculptures initially conceived as a painting project. It began to transform when I became aware that I wanted the viewer's point of view to impact directly on the form as it was perceived, so it was necessary to employ visual effects that can only be achieved through volume. I use casting technique used is lost wax bronze and materials of great strength and luminosity. Patinated or polished bronze, with its own light, gold color, creates striking effects of great personality, and polished stainless steel, like a silver mirror that reflects the surroundings.
