### CARRIE SWIM

#### ARTIST STATEMENT

Born in Houston, Texas, Carrie Swim stepped into this world, embracing any creative tool possible to process and share a message of life with an unbreakable sense of curiosity and wonder. The trials of humanity only drove her further into the miracles life can produce under pressure. Today, Carrie holds a strong lyrical abstract style in painting informed by movement and sound. She uses an ever-evolving visual language sourced in a classical training of drawing, painting, and printmaking that she gained through her BFA at Baylor and studies in Italy. By her Masters at the University of Kansas and the beginning of her seven-year career in New York City, she began to bring a tangibility to the unspoken elements of "essence" or "essential matters" through abstraction.

In her studio, you find Carrie developing large-scale ethereal abstract oil and acrylic paintings or trying new methods in mixed media. Her paintings actualize primarily through her practice of interlacing dance with painting; she calls this her "body painting" process. Carrie lets her own body receive paint like a brush from her hands to the rest of her skin and leotard. She moves with sound, time, and spirit within and beyond her. Here, she establishes a composition and roadmap for her paintings with each contact of her body to canvas. Her movements activate and unite her being to channel the continent of the journey of humanity, the divine, in an intentional yet childlike way. Each painting carries layers of intuitively chosen colors and forms, each carrying a pulsing rhythm of movement establishing an atmosphere for the viewer to step into.

Carrie's highly trained eye and hand for detail became an arrow released by her loving desire to connect within the sometimes-unseen human heart and the divine. Carrie fearlessly looks straight into the heart of man and all creation, embracing its cracks, its gold, and its beauty. Here, she challenges her limits with paint for the sake of growth and discovery of the world. Carrie continually reaches far beyond herself to other disciplines and Fine Arts communities. She continually collaborates with dance collectives in New York and Houston and facilitates healing and trauma-informed art workshops worldwide. Her heart is ever ready to learn and share the unity and healing the practice of art can bring to all.
