From her studio in Venice Beach, California, New Orleans native Victoria White wears many hats: painter, sculptor, philosopher, mentor, and teacher. She is renowned for her commanding, large-scale monochromatic portraits that pay homage to the luminaries—artists, musicians, thinkers, actors, and athletes—who ignite her inspiration. White's artistic journey emerged from an unexpected turn; a serious health battle necessitated leaving behind her career in corporate law. This challenging period became transformative, leading her to discover a profound synergy between philosophy and painting. Her resulting artworks are distinctive, seeking to illuminate not merely the physical appearance but the very soul of the individuals she portrays. White also draws creative energy from nurturing the next generation, serving as a volunteer teacher and director at Indivisible Arts. In this nonprofit, she imparts lessons on creativity, consciousness, and connection to youth.

In 2024, I exhibited at the L.A. Art Show and the Art Wynwood Art Fair at the Miami Boat Show. This year, many exciting opportunities are lined up, including brand partnerships, event appearances, hotel residencies, and being a featured artist at the F1 Grand Prix in Miami. I will return to the U.S. Open of Surfing in Huntington Beach in early August. Additionally, I have an upcoming solo exhibition at the Bergamot Station Art Center in Santa Monica in September; I will also return to Miami for Miami Art Week in December, presenting another solo exhibition.
